Artists of the Month—

Winslow Elliott Wedin and Carol Donahue Wedin

Winslow and Carol Wedin have spent their lives promoting and contributing to Art and Architecture. Both attended the University of Minnesota and took many classes together in printmaking, pottery and life drawing. Carol's direction was in Business and Photography. Winslow's was in Architecture obtaining a Bachelor of Arts and Bachelor of Architecture degree from the University of Minnesota. After several years of private architecture practice in Minnesota, Winslow got a Master of Architecture degree and a PHD in Urban Planning and a minor in Education. Winslow was introduced to watercolor by Ed Young, a friend of his artist father and an art professor at the University of Minnesota. Ed taught the Architect students watercolor rendering

techniques and Minnesota architects were known for their fine watercolors. Winslow was named after watercolorist Winslow Homer. He is a licensed Architect and has projects in the USA, Canada, Madeira, Portugal and Saudi Arabia. He taught Art, Architecture and Interior Architecture at six Universities and guest lectured at many colleges in the USA. Winslow designed and Carol, as a Real Estate Broker, were the developers, contractors and salespeople on the first Condominium townhouses built in Talahassee. Carol's interest in watercolor began in Dhahran, Saudi Arabia in 1977. She was not permitted to photograph anything and turned to watercolor to record buildings and culture. Her first one-woman watercolor show was at the University Community Center where she also taught pottery classes. There, Winslow, as professor taught Architecture and watercolor rendering techniques. In 1979 Carol was the founding member and first President of the Leon County/Tallahassee Watercolor Society. It still exists today and has about 200 members. In June 1982 Carol became a charter member of the Palm Beach Watercolor Society. She has been Membership Chairperson, Secretary, Newsletter Editor and Producer, President and is now our Treasurer. Winslow was also the President of the Palm Beach Watercolor Society. Winslow's Architecture has won awards, been published worldwide and his paintings and sculptures are in many private collections. The Boynton Beach City Hall has his sculpture "Alien Robot" on display. Carol's largest sale at one time was eight watercolor paintings to a Minneapolis Juice Bar. They were called "Not TOO Still, Still Life." Architecture, watercolor, sculpture, acrylic, computer drawings, graphics, photography, live theater, sailing, swimming, cooking, entertaining, traveling, volunteering and competitions have been the Wedins interests for over fifty years. Carol and Winslow were married in June 1957 and have two children, Maya and Boyd and three grandchildren...Kayla 7, Connor 5 and Kenley 1.
